1. WBHE Tournament Directors:

2. Game Format:
  - A. Two, 23 minute run time periods – clock starts immediately after warm-up is finished – no exceptions. The last minute of the second period will be stop time.
  - B. One three minute warmup per game.
  - C. One time out **per game** allowed per team.
  - D. Games that are tied at the end of regulation will be decided via Shoot-Out
  - E. Shoot-Out format – best of three shooters, if still tied, sudden death shoot out. Any player(s) can repeatedly shoot in sudden death. Visiting team shoots first.
3. Rules & Regulations:
  - A. Unless otherwise specified, all play will be governed by the official CBHA rulebook.
  - B. Goalies may play on multiple teams during the tournament (with approval).
  - C. Team placement in various divisions will be determined by the WBHE Tournament Directors.
  - D. All players must play at least two round robin game in order to participate in playoff games. All goalies must play at least one round robin game in order to participate in playoff games.
  - E. Timekeepers are officials too and can report major or match penalties, should they witness it, to the officials presiding over the game. If necessary, the timekeeper will assist the officials in writing the incident report post-game.
  - F. Teams must wear matching uniforms – these uniforms should all be the same base color with a heat pressed number. Matching shorts and socks are NOT required for tournament play.
  - G. Teams are allowed to have a maximum of 25 players on their roster at any time. A maximum of 20 registered players can be on the bench for a game, plus two goalies (1 in net and 1 on the bench). Teams cannot have 21 players on the bench for a game with no back-up goalie.
  - H. Teams are allowed to have a maximum of three coaches on the bench. All coach's names must be listed on the game sheet.
  - I. FANS - Any inappropriate behaviour by fans towards players and officials will not be tolerated. Unruly fans will be asked to leave the soccer center immediately and teams will be subjected to a **\$100 fine per incident** by the league. Multiple incidents will result in the team being suspended from the tournament.
  - J. Rosters are to be submitted no later than April 22, 2022.
  - K. As a show of good sportsmanship we encourage teams to fist bump with gloves on with their opponents and the game officials immediately after the game. This is not mandatory – if you do not feel comfortable doing so please refrain.



#### 4. TEAM STANDINGS:

- A. Round robin games: Regulation OR Shoot Win = 2 Points; Shoot Out Loss = 1 Point; Regulation Loss = 0 Points.
- B. If teams are tied in the standings after all round robin games have been played the tie will be broken via the following format: i) Goals for and against TOTAL; if still tied ii) Penalty Minutes TOTAL; if still tied iii) winner of head to head game (IF APPLICABLE); if still tied; iv) TBD by WBHE Executive.

#### 5. PLAYOFFS:

- A. The top 4 teams in each division will play off in a 1 game semi-final. If the game is tied at the end of regulation a shoot out will occur. Shoot-Out format – best of 3 shooters, if still tied, sudden death shoot out. Any player(s) can repeatedly shoot in sudden death. Visiting team shoots first.
- B. The winners of the semi-final games will play off in the final game. Should teams be tied in the standings the following will be used to decide placement:
  - i. Team with the most round robin wins
  - ii. Number of goals for in all four games played (excluding shoot out goals).
  - iii. Number of goals against in all four games played (excluding shoot out goals).
  - iv. Number of penalty minutes received in all four games played.
  - v. Coin flip conducted by tournament director (who will decide which team is heads and which team is tails).
- C. Suspensions – all fines and suspensions are listed below. Any player incurring a suspension and fine will not be eligible to play until the fine is paid in full. Suspensions cannot be appealed.
- D. Equipment – All player and goalie equipment must be CSA, Knapper or D-GEL approved.

**Please note the following:**

- Officials include all WBHE Executive members, all referees and all timekeepers.
- Players who accumulate two suspensions will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
- Actions deemed serious enough to bring in the Soccer Centre staff may/will result in Soccer Centre Discipline that is above and beyond WBHE.
- All suspensions are automatic and the player must sit out the next game(s). **Fines must be paid prior to the player returning to tournament play; failure to do so will result in further fines/suspensions.** Players who are suspended and attempt to play will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament. Team reps who allow suspended player(s) to play will also be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
- All above suspensions/fines are guidelines only and the WBHE executive reserves the right to increase the fines and suspensions on a “per case” basis.
